I received your letter
this morning with pleasure, as letters are
always welcome dear.
Glad to hear of the Holidays you had, as
it would be a rest as you say.
Sorry that our Dora is not so well, &
hope she is soon better again, I am just
experiencing a bad cough, which is among
most of the boys in the army at present.
Glad to hear of your going to the party in
aid of the choir & hope you enjoyed it, by
the way have you got in the choir yet.
You are coming out with going to sing
at the Christmas party, if you can't
manage you must send for Margaret, &
she will sing for you. (not half.)
I had a PC from Walter Taylor this morning,
& he says St Saffield has gone to Longmoor,
but he will be in the R.I.D., & I shant see him

unless by accident ~~or~~ something else.
It is very cold weather here, & frosty at
present time, as I discover in the snow at
Amisworth just now.

We are getting better food at present &
I hope it continues to be better than
it has been lately, but we have no
sugar in the tea, & puddings etc, & they
don't taste half so good dear Emma.
We have a fire in the hut at night, & it
is no bad, & more comfortable than
was previously.

I think I shall be on leave next weekend
but don't build on it as things are
a bit uncertain yet, I don't know
how I am going to do it, as I shall have
to pay half fare, & money is scarce at
present Emma, I don't know of any news
just now so will close again, you might
let Father read this Emma, & I bless
you, & am at Home.

Peter married Bertha Rothwell, whose parents owned a poultry farm, and they bought him a flak jacket.

When the shell fell it killed all the men in the picture except Peter.

There was a hole in the back of his coat and so he was almost certainly saved by the jacket
